4/4/10 EASTER SUNDAY	Luke 24: 1-12 Acts: 10: 34-48 “Even the Gentiles”		Again, Luke makes it clear that the Good News of Jesus Christ is good news for ALL people. This is an inclusive gospel with widespread and open arms, welcoming all who will enter.	White Communion – in Pews
4/11/10	Acts 5: 27-32 John 20: 19-31 “Ockham's Razor”		A healthy skepticism about religious claims can fit quite comfortably within a robust religious faith.	White
